Figure 1: Histogram of Questions Asked Per Case (1979-1995)

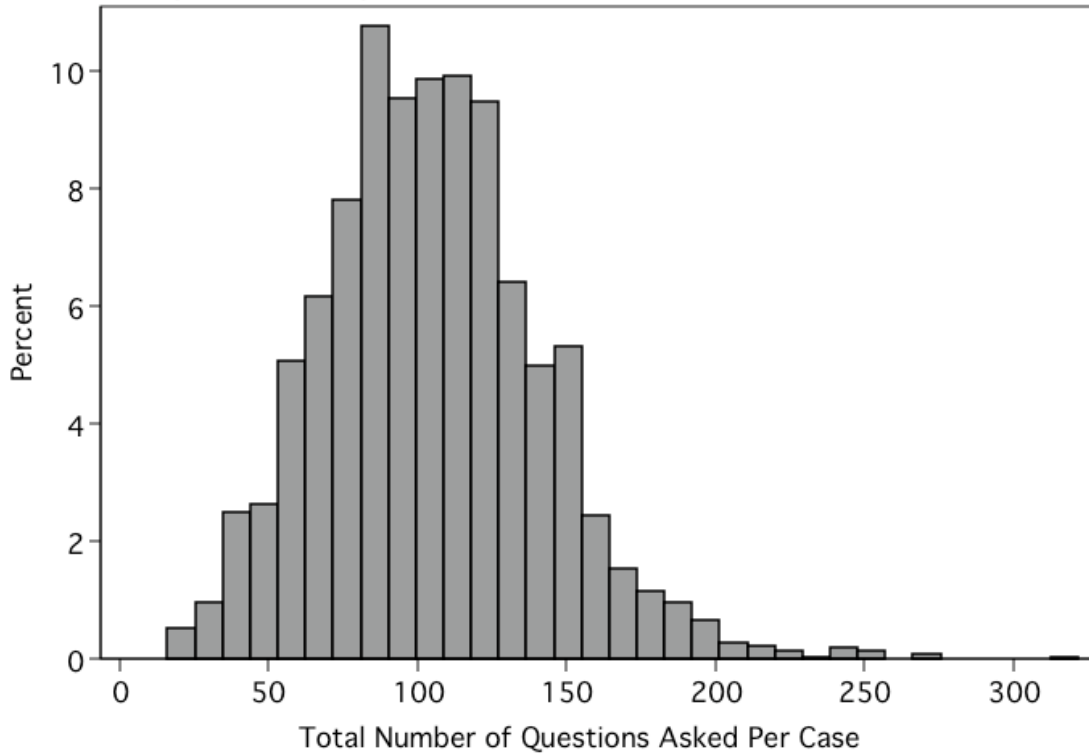


Figure 2: Average Number of Questions Per Case (1979-1995)

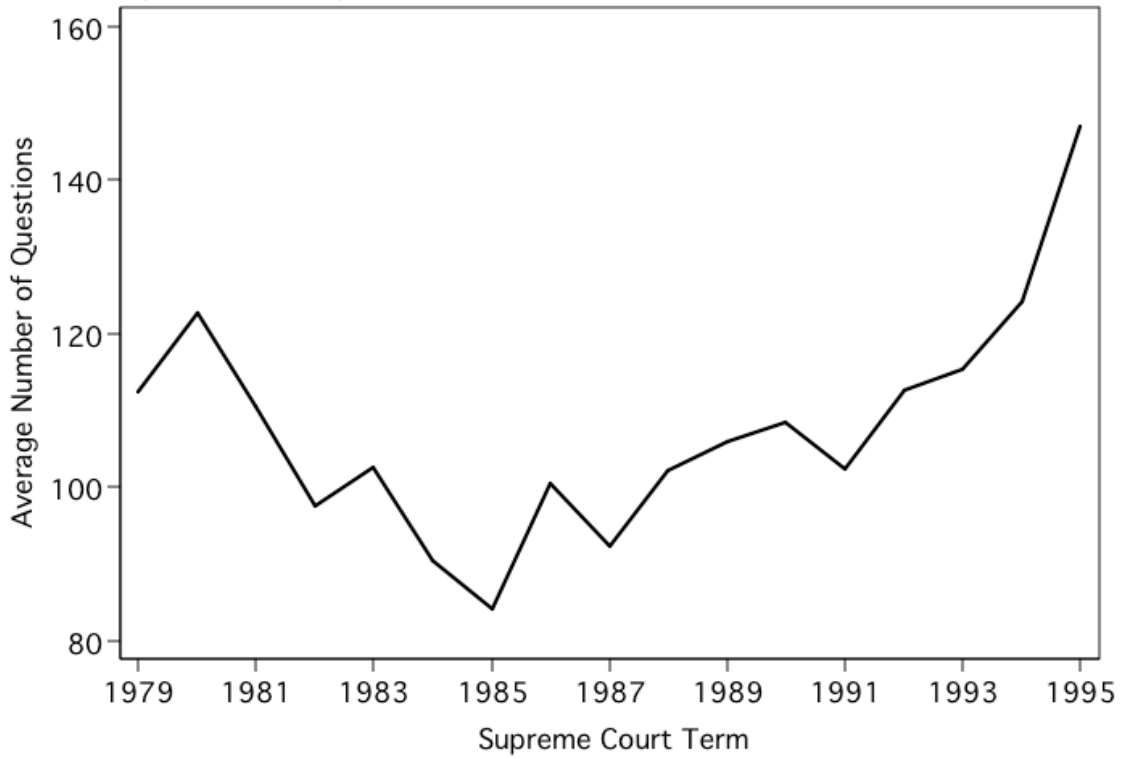


Figure 3: Average Number of Words Spoken by the Justices (1979-1995)

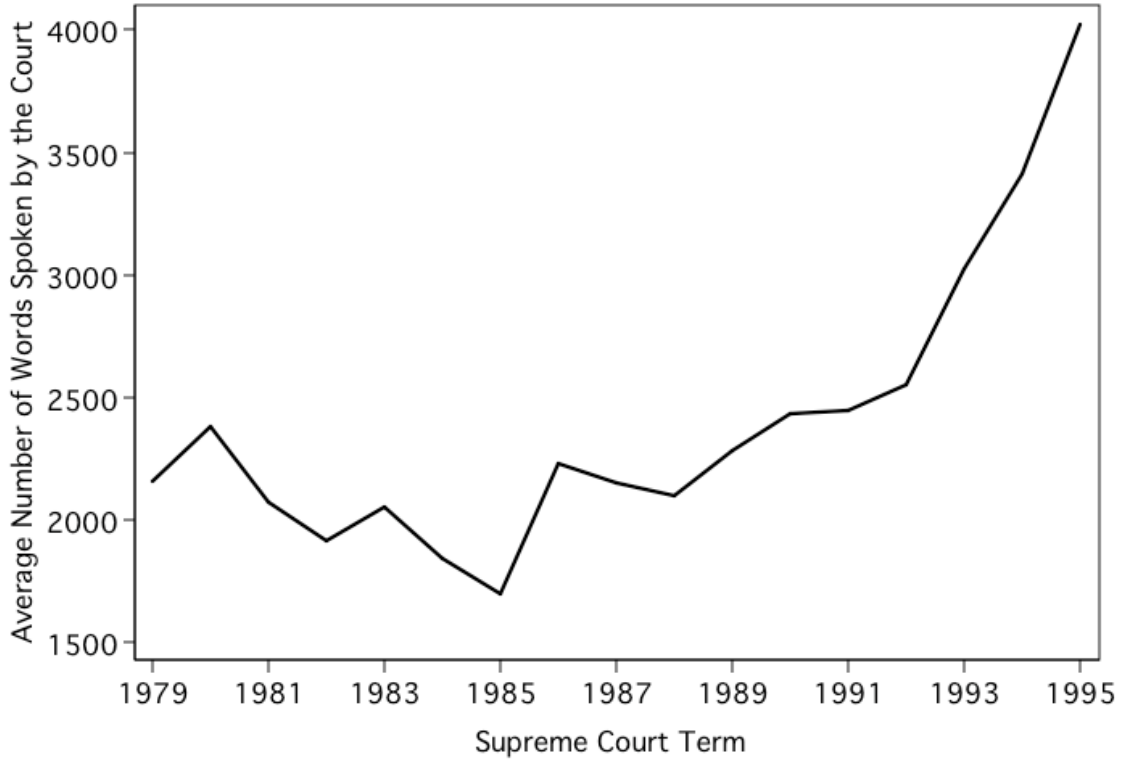


Figure 4: Influence of Question Differential on Likelihood of Merits Victory

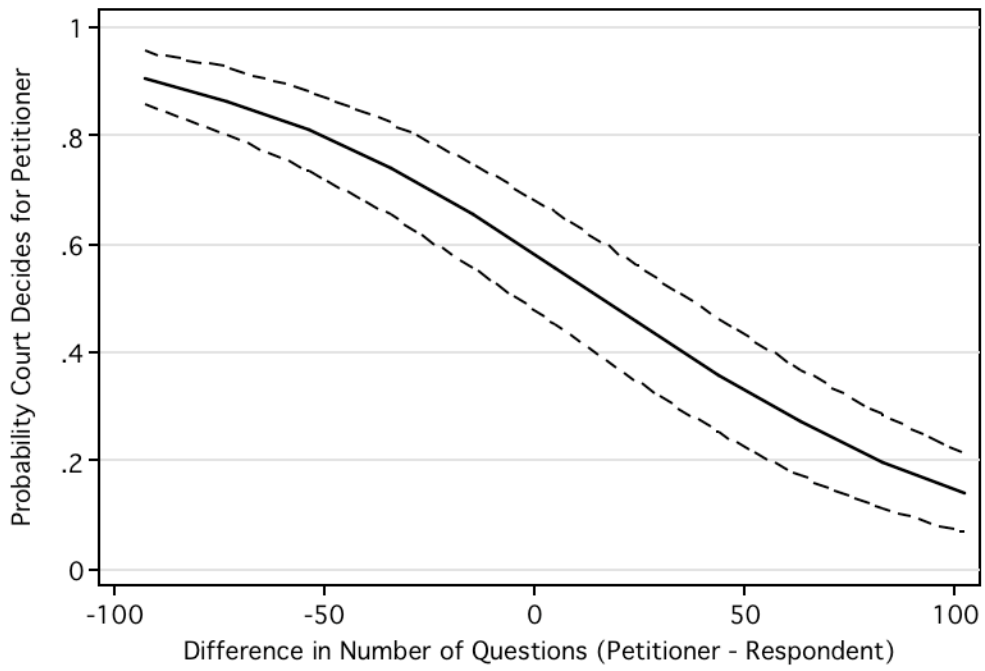


Figure 5: Influence of Word Differential on Likelihood of Merits Victory
